

# About the **Foundation**

The Breast Cancer Foundation was established in September 2009 by Directors Kim Lund, James Bovell, and John Broadbent. This year is our 14th Anniversary as a charity and the 15th year for the gala dinner.

The Foundation is a charitable organization registered with the Cayman Islands Government and was initially created to provide financial support to local charities who were offering financial aid to local breast cancer patients, we still support both CI Cancer Society and the LCTG's. In more recent years the BCF has taken on the role of main service provider for anyone living here in Cayman who is worried about or diagnosed with breast cancer. It is vital that everyone learns the importance of early detection and have access to information and treatments for breast cancer. Our local survivors are proof that we can overcome the battle with breast cancer, through the support of the Breast Cancer Foundation, and we can make a difference by giving the gift of hope, support, health and life...one survivor at a time.

#### The funds raised by the Foundation are utilized in these ways:

- Financial assistance along with travel & accommodation for surgeries/treatments overseas for breast cancer patients. Mammogram vouchers. Provision of prosthetics, special bras, essential postsurgery pressure bras, wigs, and lymphatic sleeves. Supplying vital medical equipment and training to enhance treatments given to breast cancer patients at hospitals here in Cayman.
- Running our year-round Awareness Program, taking our knowledge to companies, organizations, communities, schools, colleges etc., to spread the word about signs and symptoms of breast cancer. early detection is the key to survival.
- Running our Wellness Program providing a monthly support group, yoga, exercise, dietary advice & assistance, massage, counseling, acupuncture, lymphatic treatment, medications and running the cold capping service enabling patients undergoing chemotherapy to keep their hair and much more.

## **Our Board of Directors**




### Kim Lund
