About the Foundation

The Breast Cancer Foundation was established in September 2009 by Directors Kim Lund, James Bovell, and John Broadbent and 2024 sees us celebrate our 15th anniversary.

The Foundation is a charitable organization registered with the Cayman Islands Government and was originally created to provide support to local breast cancer patients. We work tirelessly within the community to promote self-awareness, early detection and to provide a full and comprehensive holistic Wellness program.

We now have over 450 ladies (and gentlemen) who are current patients, survivors, and thrivers on our Wellness Program, which for such a small island is a shocking number. We know we only scratch the surface as so many ladies are so very private, choosing to journey alone or with little support. As a Foundation we help with awareness, prevention, diagnosis, treatment, monitoring, counselling, support, financial support, and wellness. Our goal is to achieve a three-island wide Early Detection Program as we are so cognizant that early detection saves lives. By raising awareness, we hope that someday the numbers we are seeing start to fall rather than increase. It is thanks to the generosity of people and companies such as yours that we can work towards this goal.

This year it will be the 14th Annual Light up the Night Beach Walk, from Public Beach to The Ritz-Carlton Resort, where everyone can grab a water and a cookie then turn around and walk back. It is vital that everyone learns the importance of early detection and have access to information and treatment of breast cancer. Our local survivors are proof that we can overcome the battle with Breast Cancer, through the support of the Breast Cancer Foundation, and we can make a difference by giving the gift of hope, support, health, and life... **one survivor at a time.**

How the funds are utilized

- Financial assistance along with travel & accommodation for surgeries/treatments
 overseas for Breast Cancer patients, mammogram, and ultrasound vouchers free to those
 who need them, providing prosthetics, special bras, essential post-surgery pressure bras,
 wigs and lymphatic sleeves. Supplying vital medical equipment and training to enhance
 treatments given to breast cancer patients at hospitals in Cayman.
- Running our year-round Awareness Program, taking our knowledge to companies, organizations, communities, schools, colleges etc., to spread the word about signs and symptoms of breast cancer, early detection is the key to survival.
- Running our WELLNESS PROGRAM providing a monthly support group, yoga, exercise, dietary advice & assistance, massage, counseling, acupuncture, lymphatic treatment, medications and running the cold capping service enabling patients undergoing chemotherapy to keep their hair.
